Age Groups: Grade school camp is for fall 4th graders through 6th graders. Middle school camp is for fall 6th graders thru 9th graders. High School camp is for fall 9th graders through June 2020 graduates. Campers who are about to go into either the 6th and 9th grades have the option of choosing if they'd like to join the older or younger group, depending on their preference and comfort level.

Dates and times: High School Camp registration Sun. July 19, 3pm. Camp begins 5pm and ends Fri. July 24 at 1pm.
Grade School Camp registration Sun. July 26, 3pm. Camp begins at 5pm and ends Thur. July 30 at 3pm.
Middle School Camp registration Sun. Aug. 2, 3pm. Camp begins 5pm and ends Thurs. Aug 6 at 3pm.

Directions: (Please don't trust your GPS – you'll get lost!) Ortoha Youth Camp is located at Lost Lake 28 miles northeast of Tonasket. Take the Bonaparte Lake Exit on Highway 20 which is approximately 20 miles from either Republic or Tonasket. Go past Bonaparte Lake and keep to the left for approximately 7 miles following the signs to Lost Lake. Ortoha Youth Camp is located on the left just before reaching Lost Lake Campground. You will see our sign.
