Dates and times: High School Camp registration starts on Aug. 1 at 3pm. Camp begins on Sunday at 5pm and ends on Friday Aug. 6 at 1pm.

Directions: (Please don't trust your GPS – you'll get lost!) Ortoha Youth Camp is located at Lost Lake 28 miles northeast of Tonasket. Take the Bonaparte Lake Exit on Highway 20 which is approximately 20 miles from either Republic or Tonasket. Go past Bonaparte Lake and keep to the left for approximately 7 miles following the signs to Lost Lake. Ortoha Youth Camp is located on the left just before reaching Lost Lake Campground. You will see our sign.
