**Dates and times:** Junior Week check-in starts at 3pm on July 24th and camp begins at 5pm. Camp ends on July 28th at 3pm. Senior Week check-in starts at 3pm on July 31st and camp begins at 5 pm. Camp ends on August 5th at 1pm.

**Directions:** (Please don't trust your GPS – you'll get lost!) Ortoha Youth Camp is located at Lost Lake 28 miles northeast of Tonasket. Take the Bonaparte Lake Exit on Highway 20 which is approximately 20 miles from either Republic or Tonasket. Go past Bonaparte Lake and keep to the left for approximately 7 miles following the signs to Lost Lake. Ortoha Youth Camp is located on the left just before reaching Lost Lake Campground. You will see our sign.
